

**HAZARDOUS WASTE  
SATELLITE  
ACCUMULATION AREA  
BASIC RULES**

**1. CONTAINERIZE ALL WASTE**

- DO NOT ACCUMULATE UNCONTAINERIZED OR UNPACKAGED WASTE

**2. CLOSE ALL WASTE CONTAINERS**

- EXCEPT WHEN ADDING OR REMOVING WASTE

**3. LABEL ALL CONTAINERS**

- “HAZARDOUS WASTE”
- IDENTIFY CONTENTS OF CONTAINER
- WRITE DATE ON HAZARDOUS WASTE LABEL WHEN CONTAINER IS FULL

**4. STORE CONTAINERS OF LESS THAN 55 GALLONS (7.5 ft<sup>3</sup> or 210 liters) OR ONE QUART (950 milliliters) OF ACUTELY HAZARDOUS WASTE**

- AT 55 GALLONS OR ONE QUART OF ACUTELY HAZARDOUS WASTE, MOVE WASTE TO 90-DAY ACCUMULATION AREA
- THE SUPERVISOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MOVEMENT OF WASTE TO THE 90-DAY ACCUMULATION AREA

**5. ESTABLISH SATELLITE AREA AT OR NEAR THE POINT OF WASTE GENERATION**

**6. CONTROL THE WASTE**

- IF MORE THAN ONE GENERATOR SHARES THE SAME SATELLITE AREA, EACH GENERATOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN WASTE
